Line Crew Ground Support Training will be delivered in Thunder Bay over 15 weeks to prepare participants for employment opportunities in the construction of the Wataynikaneyap Powerline Project and the Powerline Sector. This specialized certificate course is open to women and men and will include climbing at heights, operating equipment, classroom learning and training outdoors. Preference will be given to applicants from the 22 Wataynikaneyap Power owner First Nations. Participants for this course must meet the following requirements:

- √ Valid G driver's license
- √ Must be age 18+
- √ Grade 12 diploma is preferred

Applications will be accepted on a continuous intake. Selection of applicants for the first round will begin March 23, 2018. Four rounds of training will be offered with the first two beginning April 9, 2018 and August 13, 2018.

Wataynikaneyap Power is equally owned by 22 First Nation communities (51%), who have partnered with an experienced industry leader, Fortis (49%) to construct and own a powerline connecting 17 remote First Nations in Northwestern Ontario.
