## **WABIGOON LAKE OJIBWAY NATION TRUST AGREEMENT**

The Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation Trust is neither a First Nation nor a person. It is a separate body operated by a Board of Trustees. The Trustees appointed are made up of two Community Trustees that live on reserve; one Trustee who is resident in the Dryden area and one Independent Trustee who must be a Trust Company.

Your Trustees are:

Cori Brown (on reserve)  
Donna Chief (on reserve)  
Ethel Jensson (Dryden area)  
Peace Hills Trust Company (Trust Company)

Peace Hills Trust holds all of the Trust money in a Trust Account. Peace Hills can only pay out money from the Trust Account by following the rules of the Trust and with all the Trustees approval.
