Tree Nursery Head Grower

Summary: The Tree Nursery Grower will work under the supervision of the Tree Nursery Manager and is responsible for ensuring adequate quantities of high quality seedlings are grown for the Wabigoon Anishinaabe Gitigewin Corporation which produces forest tree seedlings for forest renewal programs.

Job Duties:

- Establish the environmental conditions required to grow quality trees
- Regulate greenhouse conditions, and indoor and outdoor irrigation systems
- Assess and determine the type and quantity of stock to grow
- Plant seeds and transplant seedlings
- Constant monitoring, evaluation, and assessment of seedling crops during the growth stage
- Care of growing trees by watering, weeding, and removing dead or damaged trees
- Know how to spot disease or insects while working closely with staff directly responsible in the growing process is essential
- Ensure all tree testing is completed and sent out in a timely manner
- Be willing and able to apply chemical and biological solutions to trees to protect against disease or insects or to enhance growth
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Tree Nursery Manager

Qualifications:

- Completion of post-secondary education in Green House Management or Horticulture and a minimum of two (2) years' related work experience; or a combination of related education and experience.
- Ability to perform general physical activities such as lifting, bending and standing for extended periods of time.
- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written
- Excellent problem-solving skills
- A good handle on quality monitoring throughout the growing process
