The Waasigan Transmission Line is a proposed double circuit 230 kV transmission line between Thunder Bay and Atikokan and a single-circuit 230 kV transmission line, between Atikokan to Dryden.

It is currently being developed by Hydro One with construction expected to begin in 2024.

Gwayakocchigewin Limited Partnership (GLP) is a First Nation partnership owned by Eagle Lake First Nation, Fort William First Nation, Lac La Croix First Nation, Lac Seul First Nation, Nigigoonsiminikaaning First Nation, Seine River First Nation, Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation, and Ojibway Nation of Saugeen. The First Nations are participating in the development of the Project.

GLP is seeking information from its partner communities on First Nation businesses interested in future contracting on the Project.

All information gathered will be retained by Gwayakocchigewin LP (GLP) and recorded in the Business Directory. The information will be used to assess First Nation business readiness for the project and to provide the future construction contractor a list of interested companies.
